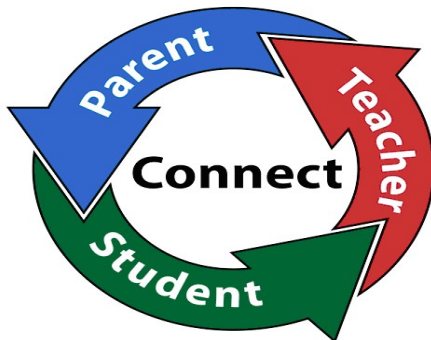
Parents SATs meetings
